Young Adult Ambassadors



- Who: Young Adult Ambassadors (YAA ;-) up to 8 ambassadors aged between 16 and 25. A Link Trustee will be appointed.
- Why: widening participation to feed ideas and priorities from young adults to trustees for dissemination and action within new and existing projects; to encourage events geared towards younger demographic.
- What: YAA meet separately at least four times per year, and then join trustees meetings at least four times per year for an 'ideas from the YAA' slot during trustee meetings.

How: Appointments made by trustees via YAA application form which should include:

- Questions around what motivates applicants and what they feel they could offer;
- Invitation to make suggestions for events/projects outlining how those ideas relate to SSB aims and objectives.

What's in it for YAAs?

- The chance to give voice to and act upon environmental concern;
- confidence- and self-esteem building;
- skills and CV development;
- peer group camaraderie and events;
- increased social cohesion and well-being;
- 'active hope'.

What's in it for SSB?

- Widening participation;
- opportunity to learn from those who will be most impacted by climate change and other issues of sustainability;
- ensuring SSB activities relate to the wider community;
- long-term viability of SSB.



 These are early days in the development of the YAA scheme and details are far from 'set in stone';

 All we would like to achieve this evening at the AGM is to ask members to vote for or against SSB trialling this type of YAA scheme in 2021.
