## SUSTAINABLE SOUTH BRENT - BIKE BANK 1 - Information and Guidance



The South Brent Bike Bank was established by SSB in 2015 as a community resource offering a free lease of a bike for up to 7 days and promoting sustainable transport in and around South Brent. The bikes are ideal for new riders as they are easy to use and well suited to Devon being light and with plenty of gears for those hills. Each lease includes helmet, lights and a lock to get you on the road as well as a support pack full of advice, tips for new cyclists, and links to cycling organisations in the area and maps. The Bike Bank is currently open to adults over 18 years and those aged 16 - 18 years with parental consent.

To borrow a bike you must register on the scheme. To register:

- Or download and complete a registration form from the website and email it to [bike@ssb.org.uk](mailto:bike@ssb.org.uk)
- Or complete a paper registration form from the Perspex Holder adjacent to the Bike Bank at The School House, Old School Community Centre and deliver it to **Penny Wainwright 1 Balmoral Villas, Station Road, South Brent TQ10 9BB**

Once you have registered, further instructions will be emailed to you and you will be able to choose and book out a bike from the green, secure cycle store at The School House, The Old School Community Centre.
